



## REPORT FROM THE INTERNATIONAL OFFICE – 2017 ACTIVITIES

***"The mission of IPPS, with a focus on the global community of those involved in horticultural plant production, is to share knowledge, information, and skills; to provide guidance and support for lifelong career achievements; to increase recognition of the profession; and to maximize the integration of research, education, and horticultural knowledge."***

Two-Thousand Seventeen saw the International Board of Directors continue with full implementation of the Strategic Plan, including improvements to the new IPPS website, continued development of the roles and responsibilities of International Board, and assisting two new emerging regions, China and India, to get established. Other global areas expressed interest in forming new regions.

The Board continued to develop the roles and responsibilities the Society identified it needs fulfilled from staff and directors. A new International Editor has been named to replace our long-time outgoing Editor, Charles Heuser, who is retiring after the publication of Volume 67. Bob Geneve will assume those duties as the Society fully transitions from printed Proceedings to digital format only.

While Regional membership decline has slowed, we are very pleased with the increase in student membership. We anticipate that as new regions become established, membership will increase in these emerging areas

IPPS is now in its seventh year of utilizing the publishing services of the International Society for Horticultural Science (ISHS) to print and distribute the book and CD forms of the *Proceedings*, while continuing to post all the papers on its PubHort website and the new IPPS website. The agreement with ISHS will terminate with the production of Volume 67, in 2018. Beginning with Volume 68, International will no longer offer printed books to its membership. All IPPS Proceedings are now available on the IPPS website.

Volume 66 of the *Combined Proceedings* was printed in December, with distribution in early 2108. Distribution to members included 481 books and 186 CDs. Forty-three libraries from around the world pre-purchased books and CDs to keep their collections up to date.

The International Board held its annual meeting in conjunction with the International Tour and European Regional Conference. See Highlights of the Meeting, below. The Board also conducted business via three telephone conference meetings during the year.

### **MEMBERSHIP**

2017 saw an overall membership increase of less than 1%. Unfortunately, paid memberships dropped this year by 86, a 6% drop. Official membership tallies<sup>1</sup> are counted as of June 1, 2017, with regions reporting as follows:

## **HIGHLIGHTS OF THE 2017 INTERNATIONAL BOARD MEETING**

On July 8, 9 and 11, 2017, the International Board of Directors met in Ghent and Breda, Belgium, and Amsterdam, Netherlands, with Alan Jones, Chairman, presiding. Seven regions were represented. Alan Jones provided a report on the Japan Region. Clive Larkman represented the emerging regions of China and India.

### Highlights of the meeting are as follows:

- Minutes of the March 14, 2017 conference call Board meeting were approved as previously distributed.
- Activities of the International Office were reviewed.
- Membership numbers for 2017 were reviewed.
- Investment funds were moved from managed funds to an indexed fund account. This will result in a significant reduction of administrative costs.
- The International Editor reported publication of Volume 66 (the Proceedings from 2015 conference) was in the queue to be printed by ISHS. Costs to produce the papers in book and CD form are increasing, rising to similar costs as prior to ISHS involvement.
- Reports from the various Regions were provided and reviewed.
- Reports from the various Committees were provided and reviewed.
- The Strategy Committee reviewed the strides that have been made in the past three years on the Strategic Plan created in South Africa. There remain several items that will be addressed in coming months.
- Alan Jones agreed to continue to serve as Chairman of IPPS for 2018. A new Chair will have to be selected for 2019.
- The financial outlook for the Society is extremely cautious. This year will end with a deficit due to further erosions of paid memberships and rising publishing costs for the Proceedings.
- The Sponsorship Committee recommended a revision of the sponsorship program.

- Future International Tour venues were reviewed. In 2018, the Eastern Region of North America will host the conference, followed by the Australian Region in 2019, the Western Region of North America in 2020, and Japan in 2021.

### **SUMMARY OF THE 2017 INTERNATIONAL TOUR**

The Tour, hosted by the European Region, began in London, England, on July 2, moved to Ghent, Belgium, on July 7, and ended in Amsterdam, the Netherlands, on July 14. A post-conference tour focused on northern Germany.

There were numerous stops including:

- The Royal Horticulture Society Gardens at Wisley, England
- The Royal Horticultural Society's Hampton Court Palace Flower Show at the summer palace of Henry VIII, in London
- The National Motor Museum in Beaulieu, England
- A variety of nurseries and horticultural research centers in southeast England, Belgium and the Netherlands
- The Aalsmeer Flower Auction, Netherlands, touted as the largest flower auction in the world

Involvement in IPPS and the International Tours is a rewarding experience, reminding us of the camaraderie, the shared knowledge, the respect and appreciation for different cultures, and the friendships over many years that are the hallmark of IPPS.
