1st day

Depart from Copenhagen by motor coach – 09.00 hrs. along the motorway directly to Korsør where we cross Storebælt (the Great Belt) on the second largest bridge in the world.

After reaching the island of Funen we continue to Odense for a sightseeing tour of the city. The highlights of the tour will be visits to the old village of Funen - where a light lunch will be served - and to the Hans Christian Andersen Museum. You will see the house where the famous author spent the formative years of his childhood until, at the age of 14 years, he left home for Copenhagen with the dream of becoming a ballet dancer. Your day completed, you arrive at Radisson SAS Hotel H.C. Andersen for dinner and overnight.

2nd day

After breakfast depart from your hotel and head through the wooded and agricultural landscapes of southern Funen to Egeskov Castle - a unique example of renaissance architecture and imagination. Surrounded by a beautiful park and gardens, the foundations of Egeskov Castle are oak pillars that have been rammed into the bed of a small lake and the location has, of course, not only provided suitable protection but also contributed to the beauty of the castle.

From Egeskov, drive on to Svendborg and across the narrow Sound to the village of Troense, where a visit is paid to Valdemar Castle. Lunch will be served here in Restaurant Valdemar, after which there will be time to stroll around the grounds and explore the castle.

From Troense, the tour continues through eastern Funen through small villages, such as the fishing village of Lundeberg and past historic, baronial manors and estates (Broholm, Hesselagergaard and Holckenhavn are just three of them), well hidden amongst the trees, to Nyborg - where you will see one of the oldest stone built fortified castles in Denmark.

After dinner a short drive from Nyborg will bring you to the highway and over the bridge back to Zealand. Drive on via Ringsted back to your hotel in Copenhagen, arriving at approximately 21.00 hrs.

1st day

Departure from Copenhagen by motor coach – 08.30 hrs. - taking the motorway directly to Korsør where we cross Storebælt (the Great Belt) on the second largest bridge in the world.

After reaching the island of Funen we continue through the undulating, agricultural countryside - Funen is often referred to as Denmark's garden isle - to Egeskov Castle. The castle is a unique example of renaissance architecture and imagination: surrounded by a beautiful park and gardens, the foundations of the castle are oak pillars that have been rammed into the bed of a small lake and the location has not only contributed to the protection of the castle but also to the fairytale atmosphere. Lunch in the restaurant at Egeskov.

After lunch, continue to Odense, the main city of Funen, for a tour of the city, during which you first visit the Hans Christian Andersen Museum and then see the house where the famous author spent the formative years of his life until at the age of 14 years, he left home with the dream of becoming a ballet dancer.

Once your tour of the city and visits are completed, check in to your hotel in Odense Radisson SAS Hotel H.C. Andersen for dinner and overnight.

2nd day

After breakfast, depart from your hotel and head west across Funen to the Little Belt, crossing the narrow strait by way of the suspension bridge to Jutland. Once in Jutland, continue across the peninsula to Ribe, on the west coast. Ribe is the oldest chartered town in Denmark and can trace its history back to the time when it was a thriving centre for Viking trading across the North Sea and southwards to the Mediterranean. Lunch in Ribe.

Depart from Ribe and head for the small community of Billund, for a visit of complete contrast to the time in Ribe. In Billund you find Legoland, the pleasure park where grown-ups can be children again - or at least recall the joys of childhood - and where kids can play at being grown up. During your visit to the marvellous park, you can see the world in miniature, the inspiration for which has been the popular LEGO bricks. The park also houses the fantastic "Titania's Palace" - a doll's house which has to be seen to be believed - a collection of antique dolls and a host of other pleasure treasures for the young at heart!

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From Legoland, a short drive to Jelling, where you make a brief stop to see the rune stones with runic inscriptions, popularly held to be the proclamation of the Danish state, before continuing to Aarhus for dinner and overnight.

3rd day

Aarhus is Denmark's second largest city and the final day of your tour starts with a tour of the city, which includes a visit to the superb open air museum, "Den Gamle By" or The Old Town - a collection of medieval buildings from all parts of Denmark, each of which has been dismantled, transported to Aarhus and re-assembled to re-create a medieval town environment - and in many of the houses, you will still find such activities as baking, weaving etc. going on. Located on the outskirts of the city, overlooking the Kattegat, you will also visit Moesgaard Museum to see the amazing Grauballe Man - the almost perfectly preserved, millennium old remains of a man found in peat bog where it is still possible to see the texture of his skin and complexion. From Aarhus, head around Kalø Bay and on through the rolling countryside of Mols to Ebeltoft. Lunch at a local restaurant in Ebeltoft. After lunch, stroll through Ebeltoft, one of Denmark's many, quaint small towns with cobblestone streets, half-timbered houses and picture postcard gardens. Ebeltoft claims to have the smallest town hall in the world - one thing is certain, it is not very big as you will discover during your visit. After visiting Ebeltoft the tour goes back to Copenhagen via Funen and over the bridge to Zealand. Drive on via Ringsted back to your hotel in Copenhagen, arriving at approximately 20.00 hrs.
