The IPPS is a select group of plant propagators from around the world. An original group of approximately 70 propagators met in Cleveland, Ohio (U.S.A.) in November, 1951 to form our Society which has now grown to more than 2400 individual members affiliated in one of eight regional organizations.



The motto of our Society is **To Seek and To Share**. Members are expected to seek and share information with one another by attending meetings, tours and placing articles in IPPS publications. This has been the strength of IPPS as it enters its 6th decade.



REGIONS

The International Plant Propagators' Society was founded in 1951 to promote seeking and sharing of information about the art and science of plant propagation. Currently, the Society has seven regions:

- Region of Great Britain & Ireland and Scandinavia
- IPPS Japan
- New Zealand Region
- Eastern Region of North America
- Southern Region of North America
- Western Region (USA and Canada)
- Southern African Region



MEMBERSHIP

Who may become a member?

- Society membership is restricted to **individuals in commercial enterprise, research, teaching, or extension activities.**
- Students whose program of training includes plant propagation are also welcome. As a member, you may join any region and you may also participate in programs offered by any other region.
- Anyone who is involved in the commercial area of plant propagation may join. We are not an organization for amateur gardeners, but we are an educational organization of those who propagate any kind of plants.

Everyone is encouraged to participate in our meetings, and share their ideas. We believe in both open seeking and sharing of information.

Membership is processed at the regional level, with dues being allocated to both international and regional expenses. Two membership options are available:

Option 1A, B & C - **Includes** the Combined Proceedings (Black book or CD - including papers of all the conferences of all the regions)

Option 2 - **Does not include** the Combined Proceedings and CD.

ACTIVITIES / EVENTS

Each region holds a 2-4 day **annual meeting**. The reports, lectures and discussions held during these meetings are included in the **Combined Proceedings of Annual Meetings** which is published annually. Each member paying full dues will automatically receive this volume. In addition, each region publishes a regional **newsletter**, and most regions hold one-day **workshops** and **programs**.
