## **INTERNATIONAL AWARD OF HONOR**

### **Guidelines and Criteria**

1. The candidate must be an active member at the time of the nomination. If s/he happens to retire from the Society due to ill health or even passes away, the award would still be given.
2. The candidate must have been an active member for a minimum of ten (10) years.
3. The award should recognize exceptional and distinguished service to the Society and/or outstanding accomplishments in the field of plant propagation.
4. The nominations of candidates shall be forwarded to the current International Vice-President 60 days prior to the International Board Meeting.
5. The Selection Committee shall consist of the Directors from each Region and the current International Vice-President. The Vice-President shall chair the committee.
6. The presentation of the Award of Honor shall be given in the "home" region of the recipient, and wherever possible, by that Regional Director.
7. The Vice-President and the International Director of the Region in which the recipient resides shall determine how the allocation (\$500.00) shall be spent. The International will furnish a plaque, to be presented to the recipient as agreed by the Regional Director. The Vice-President and the International Director shall decide who will write the dedicatory page in the *Combined Proceedings*.
8. Nominations for the Award of Honor are approved by the Regional Board of Directors and brought forward to the International Board of Directors by that Region's International Director.
9. Only one award recipient will be chosen per year.
